### JUANITA BEACH PARK MASTER PLAN PROPOSED AMENDMENT

August 29, 2007

Dear Neighbor:

The Parks and Community Services Department is proposing an amendment to the Juanita Beach Park Master Plan which would permit use of the historic Forbes House as a "community facility". "Community facility" is defined as "A use which serves the public and is generally of a public service, noncommercial nature. Such use shall include food banks, clothing banks, and other non-profit social service organizations; nonprofit recreational facilities; and nonprofit performing arts centers."

Currently the park master plan permits use of the Forbes House for parks offices and community meeting/event rental space. The proposed amendment would expand possible uses of the building as outlined above.
